



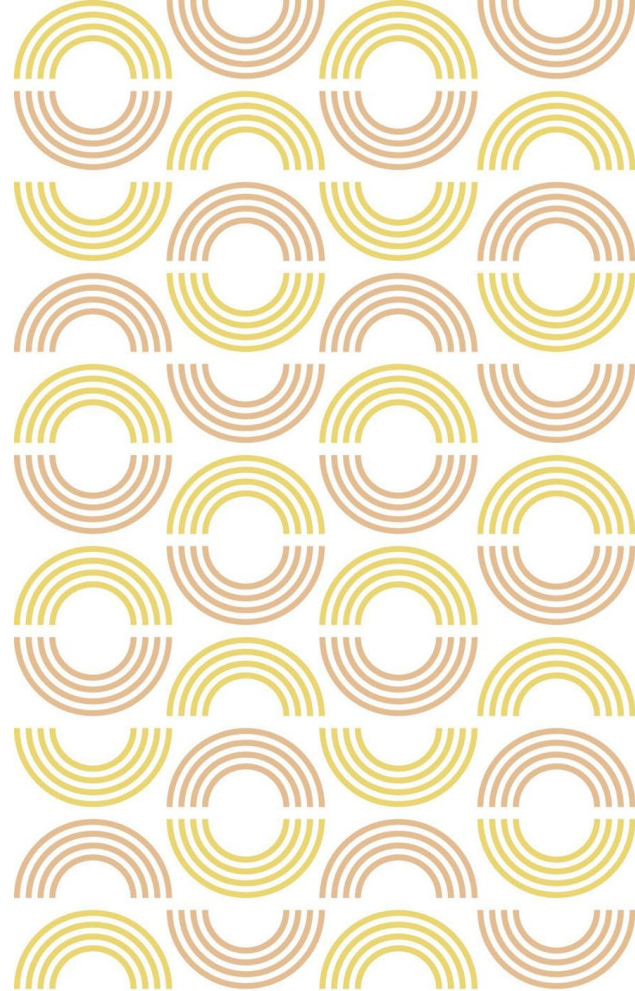

  - ✓ Improve understanding of the factors that trigger the development of resilient, inclusive, healthy and green rural communities
  - ✓ Analyze the depopulation and their impact on rural areas and rural youth
  - ✓ Establish key elements for improving rural community well-being and supporting sustainable transitions
- Core consortium: ISCTE- University Institute of Lisbon, Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, University of Naples Parthenope, University of Malaga, Research Institute for Quality of Life
